
Q1: GBHA's working Behavioral Health definition is based on membership input from our World Café.



Q1 Cont'd: How much do you identify with our behavioral health definition?




Q2: How often have you attended Greater Brockton Health Alliance meetings in the past year?


Q3: What town(s) do you represent? Select all that apply.


Q4: What community sectors do you represent? Select all that apply.


Q5: Does your organization address behavioral health?


Q6: What is the most important reason that YOU attend Greater Brockton Health Alliance meetings?


Q7: When you do not attend GBHA meetings, what is the reason? (select all that apply)


Q8: If funding becomes available from GBHA how should that money be allocated? Please rank your top three from the options below.

Q12: What suggestions do you have for making the GBHA even better?


Answered: 10 Skipped: 16

- “Grow the coalition.”


Q13: Have you ever applied for a GBHA grant?

Answered: 24 Skipped: 2




Q14: If yes, which type(s) of GBHA grant?

Answered: 7 Skipped: 19




Q15: If no, what prevented you from applying for a GBHA grant? (select all that apply)
